


How to manually eject disc from ps4

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Do you know how annoying you are when you put a quarter in a vending or washing machine and it gets stuck? There's a quiet rage inside you. Now imagine that quarter of a sixty dollar video game and it's stuck inside your new, four hundred dollar PlayStation 4 system. There will probably never be a video game console that doesn't eat the drive every now and then, at least until they get rid of them optical drive altogether. Until then, expect your hungry PS4 to gorge itself on your precious DVDs, blu-rays and game discs. Most people currently getting stuck drives are those who are trying to update some PS3 PS4 version titles, or who just see if they can play their PS3 period games. Well, there were plenty of ways to eject the inserted disk in the PS3, and there were already a few ways to do it on the PS4. This first method will be the first one you want to try, as it doesn't involve disassembling the PlayStation 4. Turn Off PS4 by holding the power button until the system is completely disconnected. Turn off all cords that are connected to the PS4 directly from the system. Place the PS4 vertically. The disk usually gets stuck when the console rests horizontally. Placing it vertically can help dislodge it. Wait about 30 minutes. Reunite all the cords. Load securely by holding the power button for 7 to 8 seconds. Cross your fingers for luck. That's it. The drive should hopefully be removed now. This method will require you to disassemble the PS4, and comes straight from Sony itself, so it's doubtful that it voids your warranty. Unlike complex procedures for ps3, it's pretty easy. Use your hands to remove the shiny part of the PS4 lid. He should step back quite easily. Images through the playstation.com There is a small black screw located between the air vents. You'll see two sections of tightly packed slots and one slot is somewhat split. Here is the screw. Image with playstation.com use a Phillips screwdriver and turn the screw counterclockwise. This shouldn't require very much pressure and you should see the stuck drive slowly get out of its slot after a few turns. Image with playstation.com pull the disc and then tighten the screw. Place the lid back, plug all the cords, and be prepared to enjoy the PS4... Once again. From the front, follow these vents until you find a slot that is not grouped with any other slots. That's where the screw will be. (Use a flashlight if necessary). Source: Sony Interactive Entertainment Once located, tighten the screw as needed. Place the HDD panel back and plug in the console. From mid-2015 to September 2016, whoever buys the PS4 probably took the PS4 CUH-1200 series. Like the above steps, start by removing the HDD lid. Using your fingers as leverage, apply even pressure near the seam to slide the top panel away. (The panel should move about 7 mm and the click will be heard). Now you will need to partially remove the HDD itself. You'll see a screw with PlayStation symbols. Just unscrew this counterclockwise so you can move the HDD to the side. Place the HDD panel back and plug in the console. If you bought a PS4 from late 2016 to today, you're probably either a PS4 Slim or a PS4 Pro that is pretty easy to distinguish from each other. Source: Sony Interactive Entertainment That's all you need to do! First First You'll notice when you open your shiny new PlayStation 4 like a tiny button on the front. Don't even get me it over as they just mingle with the machine while they're at it. Well, if you find yourself confused, which power button, and which drive pusher, look no further. Each PlayStation console has a different setting, for which the power button is compared to the disk ejection button. Here are examples of where the buttons are for everyone! Don't forget to get reading glasses, they are quite small. The PlayStation 4 Pro Power Button is on the left and the ejection drive button on the right. The buttons are on the same bar on the front of your machine. This bar is located at the bottom of the front center of the console. The PlayStation 4 Slim Power Button is on the left and the ejection drive button is on the right. They are incredibly close together, making it a hassle to deal with so just keep in mind the power button is long and square, while the ejection button is small and round. The standard PlayStation 4 power button is at the top, and the ejection button is at the bottom of the front.
